Stone Park Transformation Day



Park Beautification Agreement

On the 12th of April, 2017 KHCD signed a general beautification agreement with the City of Dallas Parks Department to begin the formal process of making permeant improvements to the park. No formal agreement had been discovered to date.

<p>The following is a Park Beautification Agreement "Agreement" between Organization/Citizen "Sponsor," and the City of Dallas Park and Recreation Department, "City," to provide maintenance services on park property for a one year term beginning on May 1, 2017 and ending on May 1, 2018; or to provide a gift of funds; or to provide furnishings.</p> <p>The City agrees to work with the Sponsor to determine the specific area of the park site. Park Beautification site plans must be approved by the Director of the Park and Recreation Department or his or her designee ("Director").</p> <p>In exchange for enjoying the benefits of the outdoors and having an attractive Park, the Sponsor agrees to one of the following: Fund Service Enhancement, Fund Park Furnishing or Perform the Services (as described below)</p> <p>SECTION 1 (check all that apply)</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> FUND SERVICE ENHANCEMENTS <input type="checkbox"/> NOT APPLICABLE Sponsor will only be able to donate money and/or equipment to the City. These donations will be used by the City for the following purpose: <u>Infrastructure</u>. Once the City receives donations, all donations then become the property of the City. <u>Amenities & beautification</u></p> <p>It is understood that this Agreement may be cancelled by either party for any reason by providing thirty days written notice to the other party. This Agreement also may be amended at any time by mutual consent and agreement of both the City and the Sponsor.</p> <p>This Agreement will be administered by the Director of the Park and Recreation Department or his or her designee, ("Director").</p> <p><i>(Refer to Section 2, Additional Terms and Conditions on Page 3)</i></p>

Requested Amenities

After the Better Block event, and evaluating what temporary improvements were successful and supported by a majority of the participants and neighbors, a list of needs was sent on June 2nd, 2017 to the Parks Department for consideration.

- Traditional slat fencing spanning approximately 100' along Edgefield and the park's southern border.
- A table measuring 4'x4'x2'
- Covered sandbox
- Large storage box for donated outdoor toys such as scooters, push-arounds. Dimensions to be designed.
- Small performance stage for neighborhood theatre, puppet shows, and musical performances
- Cafe lighting
- Outdoor duplexes
- Mural on concrete with a space galaxy theme designed and produced by neighbor of the park

Creation of Pilot Program


W. W. Stone Park is the smallest park in the Dallas Park system. It's now the first park to have a permanently installed Little Library, and will be the location of a one-of-a-kind pilot program created for adding new amenities for this kind of unique and special space.

New Amenities to be Installed on park property:

- Bicycle rack with space for 11 bicycles
- Low table for kids and adults
- Wrought iron fence, 125 ft long
- 100 amp electrical outlet
- Small riser for local live music and theatrical performances
- Mural painted by local artist and KHCD neighbor










Anchor Post Detail for Inground Models
